



Beverly Public Schools is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Meals will be provided, at a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times as follows:

To be eligible to receive free meals at the closed sites below, children must be eligible for reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch Program or be part of households that receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly foods stamps) benefits or benefits under the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF).

Children who register for Apple Village and Goldway BevRec park programs and already receive free or reduced-price school meals, are automatically eligible. For all others, an application will be sent home to parent/guardian.
