

Open for donations June 11!



The Thrift Shop will begin accepting donations again on June 11, but with many mandatory safety precautions in place. Please read the following information thoroughly so you will be familiar with the precautions both you and our staff will need to take when donating to the Thrift Shop. Please be respectful of these guidelines and other people's space.

ALL DONORS MUST WEAR MASKS

- Donations will be contactless as much as possible. Bins, tables and tents will be outside in the Thrift Shop parking lot at 198 Rantoul Street. The parking lot will be used only for donations until further notice. No donations will happen inside the building and no donors will be allowed into the building to shop until it reopens for shopping on June 17.
- Clothing donations must be brought in bags and other items should be brought in bins or boxes.
- To ease your donation process we suggest you enter the parking lot by traveling southbound on Rantoul Street to make a right hand turn into our parking lot.
- Donors will put their donations on tables and/or in bins, take a receipt if they would like one and then distance themselves for Thrift Shop staff to assess the donation's acceptability and resalability.
- If deemed unacceptable, the donor will retrieve their item(s) and be on their way. (It will not be possible to dispose of unacceptable items at the Thrift Shop. Donors will be responsible to dispose of them elsewhere.)
- All accepted donations will be "quarantined" for 24 hours (clothing) or 72 hours (household items) before being processed and put on the sales floor.
- A limited number of curbside pickups for large donations will be available starting Thursday, June 18. To schedule a time, email donationpickups@beverlybootstraps.org.

For Furniture Donations:

- Furniture donations will only be accepted by appointment. At this time, there will be limitations on the size and quantity, and no upholstered furniture will be accepted. The piece will be cleaned and disinfected outside before being brought into the shop.
