



COMMUNITY MEALS VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTION

Job Description:

- Volunteer Group will meet at St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Beverly (4 Ocean St, Beverly, MA 01915).
- Volunteer Group will help to prep the food for the meal.
- Volunteer Group will put food into to-go containers and into bags so they can be handed out.
- Volunteer Group will help hand out meals to clients as they come through the line.

Volunteer Hours:

- 2nd Friday every month 4:30-6:30 PM (2-3 volunteers per shift)
- 2nd Sunday of even # months (Feb., April, June, August, Oct., Dec.) 4:30-6:30 PM (2-3 volunteers per shift)
- 4th Sunday of even # months (Feb., April, June, August, Oct., Dec.) 4:30-6:30 PM (2-3 volunteers per shift)

Volunteer Requirements: Due to the current situation, we are requesting that all members of your group are from the same household. Anyone 16 or older is welcome. Middle-school aged children are too, as long as at least one adult accompanies them for every two children.

Keeping you safe:
