

Donation Guidelines



The Thrift Shop is accepting donations with many mandatory safety precautions in place. Please read the following information thoroughly so you will be familiar with the precautions both you and our staff will need to take when donating to the Thrift Shop. Please be respectful of these guidelines and other people's space.

ALL DONORS MUST WEAR MASKS

- Donations are contactless as much as possible. Bins, tables and tents are outside in the Thrift Shop parking lot at 198 Rantoul Street. The parking lot is to be used only for donations until further notice. No donations will happen inside the building.
- Clothing, accessories and linen donations must be brought in bags and placed in the designated bins.
- Housewares, books, and other non-clothing/accessories donations should be brought in bins or boxes and placed on the designated tables.
- Once donors put their donations on tables and/or in bins, they may take a receipt if they would like one and then be on their way. Our staff will inspect all donations after they have been quarantined.
- All donations will be "quarantined" for 24 hours (clothing) or 72 hours (household items) before being processed and put on the sales floor.
- A limited number of curbside pickups for large donations are available. To schedule a time, email donationpickups@beverlybootstraps.org.

For Furniture Donations:

- All furniture donations must be pre-approved by emailing a picture to donationpickups@beverlybootstraps.org. If approved, you must schedule a drop off appointment. At this time, there are limitations on the size and quantity, and no upholstered furniture will be accepted. The piece will be cleaned and disinfected outside before being brought into the shop.
